

MHS ORCHESTRA/WIND ENSEMBLE TRIP BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS – EUROPE 2012

1. This is a school event: school rules apply as if you were in attendance at school. The student will honor the rules and guidelines established by the Minnesota State High School League and by the rules of Minnetonka High School. This regards the use of illegal substances, as well as foul or offensive language.
2. Curfew times are set by the directors and chaperones. Curfew means: every student is in his or her assigned room and the door remains closed. Students are not allowed to leave their rooms for any reason after curfew. Breaking of curfew will result in surrender of free time choices. A student in violation will accompany a chaperone 24 hours a day for the duration of the trip. This may include sleeping on the floor in a chaperone room. All students are asked to remain in rooms until at least 6:00 a.m.
3. We will not tolerate raucous and loud behavior from students. We will be among many other guests at each of the hotels, be polite and think before you act.
4. The itinerary must be respected. We ask that students be on time. We cannot wait for tardy persons. Failure to meet chaperones for 'check-in' times will result in 24-hour chaperone escort.
5. Students are asked never to give out any information to strangers - never tell non-Tonka people where we are staying. Do not ride in cars with strangers. No taxi-rides are allowed. No non-Tonka people in your hotel rooms. No persons of the opposite gender in your room. Students are asked to travel in groups of three or more. No student should be unaccompanied at any time.
6. Chaperones may enter and search any hotel room at random, if they feel that it is necessary. The discovery of illegal substances in a room may forfeit all roommates' participation in the remainder of the trip.
7. All students are required to participate in all planned activities.
